### Affirmative

I They	<b>want need</b>	<b>to buy</b>	a raincoat.
He She	<b>wants needs</b>	<b>to exchange</b>	this hat.
Negative			
I They	<b>don't want need</b>	<b>to return</b>	these boots.
He She	<b>doesn't want need</b>	<b>to get</b>	it now.
